



MFB AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

The Missouri Farm Bureau Ambassador program provides an opportunity for young leaders to represent agriculture and Farm Bureau for one year. One male and one female applicant are selected each year at the Annual Meeting of the Missouri Farm Bureau Federation. A \$1,250 scholarship is awarded to the two ambassadors.

APPLICANTS MUST BE selected by their county Farm Bureau to participate in the statewide competition. They must be 17-22 years of age and their family must be a Farm Bureau member one year prior to the September 30 deadline.

Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a two or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.

Students wishing to apply should contact their County Farm Bureau Office.

DODGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Under this national program, the Dodge Division and its dealers are offering 50 scholarships of \$1,000 each. Completing this application will allow eligibility for other scholarships through the National FFA Foundation.

Qualifying applicants must be active in FFA and from a Farm Bureau membership family. Applicants must have documented a strong Supervised Agricultural Experience Program (SAE).

APPLICANTS MUST BE enrolled or planning to enroll in a two or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.

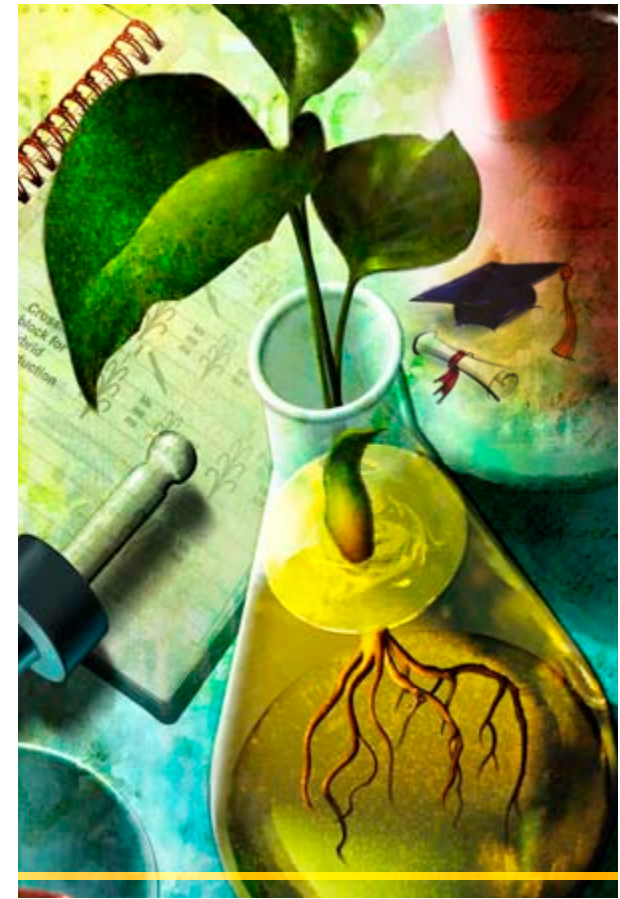

MFB FOUNDATION FOR AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP

MFB VETERINARY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2008, the MFB Veterinary Student Scholarship supports students with plans to enter a Missouri-based practice that includes large animals.

RECIPIENTS MUST BE 4th Year Veterinary School students with demonstrated interest/aptitude in mixed or large animal practice intending to pursue the profession in Missouri.

MISSOURI FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

The Missouri Farm Bureau Scholarship provides financial assistance to students from Farm Bureau families pursuing degrees at UMC. One \$1,000 award will be made in the College of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources and one in Human Environmental Sciences.

The award will be made to a qualifying sophomore, junior, or senior pursuing a bachelor of science degree in agriculture (except animal science) and human environmental sciences. Recipients or their families must be members of the Missouri Farm Bureau Federation.

MFB FOUNDATION FOR AGRICULTURE VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

STUDENTS MUST BE pursuing degrees/certification in fields related to and supportive of agriculture. This includes but is not limited to heavy equipment operations, electronics, welding, and diesel and farm machinery repair. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student.

C. R. JOHNSTON SCHOLARSHIP

The C. R. Johnston – Farm Bureau Scholarship in Animal Sciences, established in 1989, recognizes his contribution to Missouri Farm Bureau Federation and Missouri agriculture. Over \$10,000 is awarded annually.

RECIPIENTS MUST BE majoring in animal sciences and their parents must be members of Missouri Farm Bureau. In addition, recipients must have demonstrated academic achievement and have a record of leadership in agriculture.
